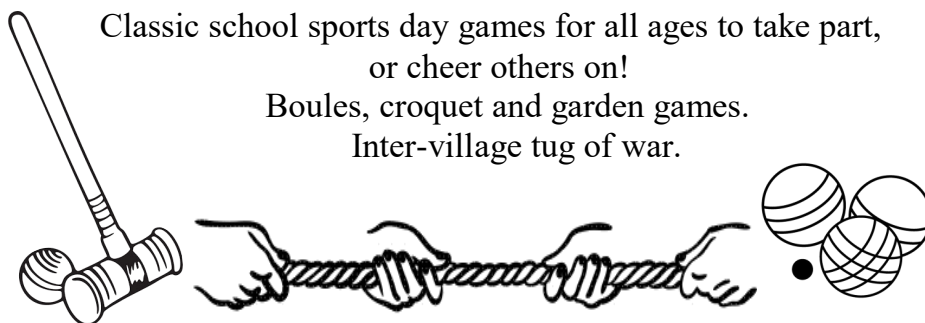

## **JOHN WHITTLE REMEMBERED**

John Whittle lived in Hargrave with his wife, Kay, for some 30 years before moving a little distance to Waverton when their house became too big for them. John had taken early retirement from Shell Research and needed to get his teeth into something when he arrived in the midst of our community. This turned out to be the writing and editing of “A History of Hargrave and Huxley”, the first edition appearing in 1988 and the second in 2008. John was a trustee of The Sir Thomas Moulson Trust and took a particular interest through the Historical Group in researching the Moulson family. He was immensely fond of all the activities our twin villages have been party to over the years and he and Kay were generous hosts to many of these.

John died in March but his funeral in April was limited in attendance by Covid 19 restrictions. His daughter and son, Debbie and Nigel, now want as many of John's friends and members of local groups with whom he was associated, to come to a Reception that they will host in Hargrave Church Hall on **Saturday 7<sup>th</sup> August from 5 – 7pm**.
